## 1. RULES

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2. RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, applies.

1.3. RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.

1.4. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.5. PYA Regulations „Principles for the organisation of PYA sailing regattas” applies.

'[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule and for which the protest committee may refuse to hold a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1 and 63.2(a).

## 2. [DP][NP] ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all boats mentioned in NoR 4.1

3.2. Competitors shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website <http://events.pya.org.pl/> and paying the required fees.

3.3. Competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Code (Regulation 19).

3.4. Each participating crew shall present the following documents at the time of final registration at the venue:

- entry fee payment confirmation
- valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least €1.500.000 (or equivalent) per incident
- Competitors under the age of 18 shall present a signed and completed parent or guardian consent and declaration form at registration
- Boat measurement certificate

Following documents are required only from Polish competitors:

- Valid medical clearance
- PYA sailors license;
- PYA advertisement license (if required)

#### 4. FEES

4.1 Entry fees are as follows via event website:

4.2 Competitors who fail to complete the entry procedure within the above deadline shall be subject to an entry fee increased by 50%.

4.3 The entry fee shall not be refunded unless the Organising Authority cancels the regatta.

6.1. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00 hrs.

#### 7. [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

7.1. All boats may be inspected for compliance with class rules since 9.00 on the first day of racing.

7.2. Any boat or equipment may be re-inspected at any time.

#### 9. VENUE

9.1. The regatta will be held in Marina Krynica Morska – Bojerowcow 4, 82-120 Krynica Morska

9.2. The racing area will be on the waters of Vistula Lagoon

#### 10. THE COURSES

#### 11. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Sailing Instructions may include a specification of discretionary penalties that may be applied by the protest committee for breaches of specified rules. The Sailing Instructions may include a specification of standard penalties that may be applied by the race committee without a hearing for breaches of specific rules; this will change RRS 63.1 and Appendix A.5. These will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 12. SCORING

12.1. At least 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

12.2. No score will be excluded before completing 4 races

### **13. SUPPORT BOATS**

13.1. All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority

13.2. All support boat drivers shall present valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least 500.000 EUR (or equivalent) per incident.

### **14. [DP] BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park or harbour.

### **15. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

Boats shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing except when using equipment provided by the race committee.

### **16. PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded in accordance with the Prize Giving Regulations published in the "Documents" section of the regatta website. The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend the number of prizes if fewer than 10 boats are entered in a given class.

### **17. MEDIA RIGHTS**

17.1 By participating in the regatta competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

17.2 Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

### **18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule RSS 3, Decision to Race. Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
