1. RULES

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2. RRS Appendix B, will apply, however RRS B5 60.2 and B8.A8 are deleted.

1.3. RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

1.4. PYA Regulations „Principles for the organisation of PYA sailing regattas” will apply.

1.5. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.6. For Medal Series Races, World Sailing Appendix MR – Umpired Medal will apply and takes precedence over any conflicting instructions. '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule and for which the protest committee may refuse to hold a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1 and 63.2(a). '[SP]' denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee or Technical Committee without a hearing, or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes A5.1.

2. [DP][NP] ADVERTISING

Sails and competitors may be required to carry advertising for event sponsors, which will be supplied by the local Organising Authority.

3. ELGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all boats mentioned in NoR 4.1

3.2. Competitors shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website <http://events.pya.org.pl> and paying the required fees.

3.3. Competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Code (Regulation 19).

3.4. Each participating crew shall present the following documents at the time of final registration at the venue:

- entry fee payment confirmation
- valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least €3.000.000 (or equivalent) per incident
- Competitors under the age of 18 shall present a signed and completed parent or guardian consent and declaration form at registration
- Boat measurement certificate

Following documents are required only from Polish competitors:

- Valid medical clearance
- PYA sailors license;

- PYA advertisement license (if required).

4. FEES

5. FORMAT

5.1. Regatta will consist of opening series, which may include any or all of following disciplines: Course Racing, Sprint Racing, Marathon, and a Medal Series, as described in the table:

Opening Series + Medal Series	Only Opening Series
15 races in opening series and medal series for iQFOiL, and iQFOiL U23 regardless of number competitors	17 races in opening series
for iQFOiL U19, iQFOiL U17+U15 fleets with 16 and more competitors	for iQFOiL U19, iQFOiL U17+U15 fleets with less than 16 competitor

5.2. All sailed races will rank in Open Polish Championship.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00 hrs.

7. [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

7.1. All board may be inspected for compliance with class rules since 9.00 on the first day of racing.

7.2. Any board or equipment may be re-inspected at any time.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTION

9. VENUE

9.1. The regatta will be held in Morska Baza Szkoleniowa Mechelinki – Nadmorska 34, 81-198 Mechelinki

9.2. The racing area will be on the waters of Puck Bay

9.3. Trailers parking - Gdyńska 25, 81-198 Mosty (54.612669, 18.495769)

10. SCORING

10.1. At least 3 races in Opening series are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

11.1. All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority

11.2. All support boat drivers shall present valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least 500.000 EUR (or equivalent) per incident.

12. [DP] BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park or harbour.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Boats shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing except when using equipment provided by the race committee.

14. PRIZES

Awards of the Polish Open iQFOiL Championships will be presented to the top three male and female competitors in the following competition categories:

Open Polish Senior Championship

Open Polish U23 Youth Championship

Open Polish U19 Junior Championship

Open Polish U17 Junior Championship

Open Polish U15 Youth Championship

The organizer may award additional prizes to the winners of individual events and categories. The organizer may change the number of prizes if fewer than 10 boats register in a given class.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

15.1. By entering the regatta, the competitor agrees to:

a) the free-of-charge recording, use, and dissemination of his/her image captured in connection with participation in the regatta by the Organiser, its partners, sponsors, and entities acting on their behalf, for documentation, information, reporting, archival, and promotional purposes related to the regatta, the Organiser's activities connected with the regatta, the promotion of sailing, and the presentation of cooperation with the regatta partners and sponsors, in particular in regatta reports, broadcasts, rebroadcasts, highlights, audiovisual materials, photographs, press publications, printed materials, presentations, websites, social media, streaming services, and other similar communication channels, without territorial or time limitations. In the case of a minor competitor, the above consent is given by the parent or legal guardian;

b) the processing of personal data contained in the regatta entry for the purposes of conducting the competition by the controller of personal data – the Polish Yachting Association, with its registered office in Warsaw (03-901), al. ks. J. Poniatowskiego 1. The competitor has been informed that providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for participation in the regatta, and that he/she has the right to access the content of his/her data and to correct it;

c) the inclusion of his/her data in publicly available lists, including regatta results and entry lists. The consent applies to the following data: first and last name, membership/licence number and expiry date, e-mail address, and date of birth.
15.2. Competitors may be required to give interviews during the regatta.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule RSS 3, Decision to Race. Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
